Large order of Bolt-A-Bin and CSP readied quickly for Nunavut

AIL Mining recently put the move on to ready 18 Bolt-A-Bin Abutment Systems and 15 tractor-trailer loads of Corrugated Steel Pipe (CSP) to ocean-ship to the far northern reaches of Nunavut.

We didn't have much notice on this one and everything hinged on the ocean-shipping schedule. Drawings, approvals, manufacturing and delivery at port all had to happen within four weeks, but we came together and got it done.

The abutments and pipes are for nine bridges and numerous drainage structures in the Amuruq exploration project, a satellite operation being developed about 50 kms from Agnico Eagle's Meadowbank Gold Mine.
